How to submit digital images for jurying.

Send good quality digital images only when submitting work for jurying for either a New Membership application or for jurying in an Exhibition.

Please isolate the work from the framing and matting and do not include distracting background.

For OSA membership consideration, the images must appear to be professional. Please send your files by email as indicated on the application or call for entry.

DO's

- Do accomplish this by doing the following in Photoshop or another appropriate system: File > Save for Web > Image Size tab > change to appropriate pixels for the longest side > Apply > Save.
- Do send your files formatted as .jpg only.
- Do ensure that the colour mode for all images is RGB or sRGB (not CYMK).
- Do use a standard resolution for all your images. (72 pixels per inch)
- Do save JPEGs at medium-high or high quality
- Do keep the largest dimension of each image in the range of 1024 pixels. You can go slightly smaller than this, please do not exceed 1024 pixels.
- Do name each image with your name... example: surname_firstname_title.jpg
 - If you are submitting a second view of a three-dimensional work, name it as follows: surname_firstname_title_1a.jpg

DON'Ts

- Don't compress the files using Zip, Stuffit or any other compression software. We may not be able to open it.
- Don't include hyperlinks to other sites with your images.
