- Each image size should not exceed 2MB. Do not compress files.
- Images must be labelled as follows:

TERMS OF ENTRY

1. Open to all emerging and established artists (18 years and over) living in the province of Ontario.
2. Artists may submit two **ORIGINAL** works of their own creation (executed without the supervision of an instructor) and completed within the past three years.
3. Reproductions and artwork previously juried or exhibited by the CFS or previously exhibited in the ECC Gallery are not eligible.
4. Eligible media include: original two dimension painting, drawing, sculpture and original/hand-pulled prints. **The CFS does not accept photographic or digital art** (however photographs and digital prints may be used as part of a collage, but should not constitute a major part of the work.)
5. Submissions must not be a copies, derivatives, or based in any way on other copyrighted or published paintings, drawings, photographs or other artistic work.
6. Only artwork by artists whose mailed entry forms/fees are received post-marked no later than the deadline date, and whose cheques are not NFS, will be eligible for jurying.
7. Entry fee must be paid in full. NSF cheques will incur a \$40. handling fee. Outstanding fees payable in cash at time of drop off.
8. All 2D artwork must be properly wired and ready for hanging. Wet paintings, faulty wires and insecure framing will not be accepted. Painting framework should have D-rings or screw eyes on both sides of the back, placed no lower than 6 inches from the top so that the picture will not lean out from the wall. Wire must be appropriate to the weight of the artwork and in its hung position must be 3" below the top of the frame so the hanging hook will not be visible. Artists' own plinths may be required for 3D art.
9. Pieces framed with glass cannot exceed 40" in width; larger pieces must use plexiglass.
10. Labels – Each piece of art must have 2 labels. Label Templates will be sent out with notice of acceptance.
11. The Jurors' decision is final. Accepted works may not be withdrawn from the show or substituted with another piece.
12. The CFS facilitates artist sales. The CFS does not sell artwork or charge a commission.
13. At the end of the exhibition, all artists are responsible for the pick up of their artwork. There are no storage facilities. The ECC and the CFS are not responsible for loss or damage to artwork that is not picked up by the closing of the show.

JURORS

Adrienne Alison is a Toronto-based sculptress. Her notable public commissions include; the 'War of 1812' monument unveiled in 2014 on parliament hill, 'C.W. Jefferies', 'Bishop Strachan' and the 'ACTRA Award'. Also deserving mention is her art as applied to medicine at Sunnybrook to create facial prosthetics for cancer and trauma victims.

Doug Purdon is a Toronto-based, award-winning painter and a recognized authority on artists' materials and their use. He taught fine art - *studio* at U of T for over a decade, is a popular speaker and is much sought after for his art product demonstrations.

- All submitted art work will be looked at digitally.
- Art work that is part of the 65th Annual Open Juried Exhibition will be selected by our jurors from the digital submissions.
- Notification of results will be sent by email to everyone who submits.
- Live jurying for Prizes will take place once the work is delivered on the required date and the show has been hung at the Etobicoke Civic Centre
